Phase III Open-Up-and-Recover-Safely-Plan (*Effective June 1, 2020*)

Please note this guidance provided herein is not comprehensive, it is intended to serve as a tool to help establish general protocols encountered in various situations. We have identified some foreseeable health risks associated with COVID-19 and have provided suggestions to mitigate those risks. Effective safety measures that protect employees and citizens are critical to a successful reopening of our state. There are unique situations not covered here, and we rely on collaboration with event sponsors and citizens using their best judgement during this unprecedented time. We must all take responsibility to protect those in our community. Thank you for doing your part to ensure the safety of all Oklahomans

❖ Individual Guidance:

- Citizens should minimize time spent in crowded environments and continue following CDC guidelines regarding social distancing
- If you are over 65 or part of a vulnerable population, continue following safer-at-home policies
- Visitation to hospitals is allowed within the guidelines provided in the OURS plan
- Visitation to senior care facilities, except for end-of-life situations, will be prohibited until affirmatively lifted by Executive Order

❖ **Activities/Facilities:**

- Effective June 1, 2020 under OURS Plan Phase III the following activities/facilities inclusive of but not limited to the list below may reopen without any limitation to group size, provided that CDC (Center for Centers for Disease Control and Prevention) sanitation and disinfecting protocols and social distancing guidelines are maintained.
 - ✓ Sporting Venues including Rodeos- also inclusive of organized sports league activities at but not limited to Kiwanis Field, Cottonwood Flats, Owens Field, & the City of Guthrie Soccer Complex
 - ✓ Large Public Gatherings
 - ✓ Outdoor Concerts
 - ✓ Festivals, Fairs, and other Outdoor Gatherings
 - ✓ Funerals and Weddings

❖ *Event staff and attendees are encouraged to wear a cloth face covering in settings where CDC recommended social distancing measures are difficult to maintain.*
